NOTICE (No.4) 2025****Preliminary****Short Title**

1. This notice may be cited as the *Public Service Departmental Arrangements Notice (No.4) 2025*.

Commencement

2. This notice commences on 21 July 2025.

Authority and purpose

3. This notice is made under sections 200 and 201 of the *Public Sector Act 2022*.

Part A – Changes relating to functions

4. Those functions listed in Column 1 of the Schedule are given to the entity listed in Column 2 of the Schedule.
5. The functions given under clause 4 of this notice listed in the Schedule are transferred to the department of government listed in Column 3 of the Schedule.

Part B – Other powers

6. On the transfer of the functions referred to in clause 5 of this notice, all public service employees of the entity in Column 2 who work on the function in Column 1, become employed in the department of government in Column 3 of the Schedule.
7. For the avoidance of doubt, the full time equivalent (FTE) positions and funding associated with the public service employees referred to in clause 6 of this notice, transfer to the department of government in Column 3 of the Schedule.
8. The following apply for each of the public service employees referred to in clause 6 of this notice:
 - a. the employee retains and is entitled to all rights, benefits and entitlements that have accrued to the person because of the person's previous employment in the entity in Column 2 of the Schedule, including, for example, accrued leave;
 - b. the employee's continuity of service is not interrupted, provided that the employee is not entitled to claim a right, benefit or entitlement more than once in relation to the same period of service;
 - c. the employee's employment in the department of government in Column 3 of the Schedule does not constitute a termination of employment or a retrenchment or redundancy;
 - d. the employee is not entitled to a payment or other benefit because the employee is no longer employed in the entity in Column 2 of the Schedule.
